  - A letter of recommendation from a member of the school faculty. This must be mailed directly from the faculty member to the scholarship chairperson, Kim Swartzel.

The completed application, including your personal statement, transcript, and letter of recommendation must be postmarked on or before April 1, 2016, to be considered. Applicants will be notified by May 1, 2016, of the committee's selection.
