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QUALIFICATIONS AND INFORMATION

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, participation in chapter and campus activities, personal goals, initiative, and financial need.

*Eligibility and Requirements: Applicants must be:

- An initiated member of an NPC sorority
- A permanent resident of Pinellas or Pasco County, Florida
- Registered as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student (enrolled in twelve semester hours) at an accredited college or university

This scholarship is paid directly to your school. Upon receipt, the money is posted to your school account.

GENERAL PROCEDURES: THIS APPLICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) OFFICIAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT (must include the spring semester of the current school year)
- 2) An essay page explaining (a) your reasons for applying; (b) reasons for your choice of major; (c) your individual goals; and (d) what your sorority means to you.
- 3) A letter of recommendation from a member of the college/university faculty, i.e., a professor, dean, or a dept chair. However, this must be emailed <u>directly</u> from the faculty member to the Clearwater Panhellenic Scholarship chair using email: CAPScholarshipChair@gmail.com, or it may be mailed to the address below. It <u>cannot</u> be included with the applicant's paperwork. Please check to be sure that your letter of recommendation has been received by April 1, 2024.

The completed application, including your personal statement, transcript, and letter of recommendation must be postmarked or emailed on or before April 1, 2024, to be considered. Applicants will be notified as soon as possible of the committee's decision.
