The Clearwater Alumnae Panhellenic Association is accepting applications for the 2020 scholarships to be awarded toward the 2020-2021 academic year.

These scholarship grants are valued at \$2,000 each or higher.

These scholarships are open to college women who are initiated members of a National Panhellenic Conference sorority, and are permanent residents of Pinellas or Pasco County (Florida), and are registered as full-time undergraduate (twelve semester hours) or graduate students (twelve semester hours) at a school that is accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

It is important that all conditions for eligibility are met and that all steps and procedures outlined in the application instructions are followed. Only fully completed applications received by the deadline will be considered eligible.

Qualifications and Information

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, participation in chapter and campus activities, personal goals, initiative, and financial need.

***Eligibility and Requirements - Applicants must meet all three:**

- An initiated current member of an N.P.C. sorority
- A permanent resident of Pinellas or Pasco County, FL (your home address)
- Registered as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student (enrolled in twelve semester hours) at an accredited college or university

This scholarship is paid directly to your school. Upon receipt, the money is posted to your school account.

*** Application Procedures – This application must be accompanied by the following to be considered:**

- Official College transcript (must include the spring semester of the current school year)
- A written statement including (a) your reasons for applying; (b) your reasons for your choice of major; (c) your individual goals and incentives; and (d) what your sorority means to you.
- A letter of recommendation from a member of the **college/university faculty, i.e., a professor, dean, or a dept. chair. This letter must be mailed or emailed directly from the faculty member to the scholarship chairperson, Kim Swartzel. It cannot be sent along with the other scholarship paperwork. Please check to be sure that your letter has been sent and received by the April 1 due date.**

The completed application, including your personal statement, transcript, and letter of recommendation must be postmarked or emailed on or before April 1, 2020 to be eligible. All applicants will be notified by May 1, 2020 of the committee’s selection. Award Recipients will be invited to our May 16, 2020 Scholarship Brunch to be formally recognized.
