From the time she entered the competitive and male-dominated career field of finance in 1980 at age 25, Janet has exemplified both empowerment and perseverance. A native of St. Petersburg, Janet received her BA from Earlham College in Sociology and Anthropology and her MBA in finance from Drexel University. After 10 years in commercial and investment banking, she co-founded a company focused on consolidating and improving healthcare in underserved Asian markets. She later founded New Spring Ventures, a venture capital fund in Radnor, PA.

Wherever she has lived, Janet has been committed to community engagement and philanthropy. While raising her two children, in 1988 she helped start a residential community for mentally handicapped young adults in Glenmoore, PA, serving on their board for ten years. After moving to CA, she was an active board member for six years on the Sophia Project, focused on homelessness in Oakland, CA and at the same time served as a board member of The Alliance for Stem Cell Research in Palo Alto, CA. Moving back to Florida in 2008, Janet is currently the Chair of the Board of Directors of The Florida Orchestra, the largest orchestra in Florida. She also serves on the Board of Trustees for Heathy St. Petersburg whose mission is to end differences in health from social or structural disadvantages.
